Core Scheme

The **core scheme** is an entitlement for all newly qualified GPs and all interested individuals will be automatically enrolled (please see [eligibility and application](#)). Core Fellows are released for 1 session per week (pro-rata) to undertake a range of supported developmental activities, including:

Induction: supported induction to your practice, PCN and the wider ICS. This includes a 1:1 with one of our GP Clinical Leads from the Training Hub.

Networking & Peer Support: access to peer support mechanisms, such as the First Five Network and Next Generation GP.

Continuing Professional Development: specially commissioned CPD to help GP participants with their role, and self directed learning opportunities

PCN Portfolio Working: support from the Training Hub to undertake portfolio/shadowing opportunities across your PCN.

Mentoring: Matched to a GP mentor.

Enhanced Scheme

The **enhanced scheme** is an exciting and innovative programme, which includes funding for a portfolio placement and/or qualification. The scheme aims to help participants develop a specialist interest.

Mid and South Essex Training Hub are pleased to fund a limited number of places on the **enhanced scheme** in 2022/23 and welcome applications from GPs who wish to develop a specialist interest to help develop their career and provide enhanced care to patients. The scheme includes:

- **All support and development provided within the core scheme**
- **Specialist Portfolio Opportunity:** weekly funded session in a secondary or community setting for up to 12 months
- **Specialist Educational Provision:** funding to support the development of specialist knowledge and understanding (e.g. post-grad certificate in medical education, etc.)

Eligibility & Application Process

The **core scheme** is nationally funded and is an automatic entitlement for all newly qualified GPs. You will need to be a:

- Qualified GP within your first 12 months post-CCT
- GP Partner or Salaried GP in a Mid and South Essex practice
- GPST3, due to qualify in the next 12 months

The **enhanced scheme** has the same eligibility criteria, but has limited places and is available through an application and interview process. The **enhanced scheme** is specifically for GPs who are keen to develop additional specialist interests.
